It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court,  
that said delinquents, Buford Frost and Ossie Hinote be, and they  
are hereby committed to the Alabama Boys Industrial School, located  
at East Lake, Alabama, until they shall each have reached the age  
of twenty-one years, or until such time as they shall have been  
legally discharged from said institution.

The health and physical condition of said Buford Frost and  
Ossie Hinote is good.
