

**AGREEMENT REGARDING THE
BALDWIN COUNTY INTEROPERABILITY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM
LAW ENFORCEMENT PLAN**

This Agreement regarding the Baldwin County Interoperability Communications System Law Enforcement Plan ("Agreement") is entered into as of the date of execution by the Chairman of the Baldwin County Commission by and between Baldwin County, Alabama, by and through the Baldwin County Commission, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama (the "Baldwin County Commission"), and City of Bay Minette, City of Daphne, Town of Elberta, City of Fairhope, City of Foley, City of Gulf Shores, Town of Loxley, Town of Magnolia Springs, City of Orange Beach, Town of Perdido Beach, City of Robertsdale, Town of Silverhill, City of Spanish Fort and Town of Summerdale (sometimes referred to herein collectively as "entities", "agencies" or "Agencies") as and subject to the terms and conditions set forth below.

Section 1. Purpose:

A. This "Agreement" establishes the permission, guidelines and technical requirements for the use of the Baldwin County Interoperability P25 700 MHz or Law Enforcement Interoperability Channels (sometimes referred to as the "System") by the following entities or agencies:

1. Local Federal Law Enforcement Agencies operating in Baldwin County;
2. State of Alabama Public Safety Agencies operating in Baldwin County;
3. Baldwin County Sheriff's Office; and
4. Municipal Local Law Enforcement Agencies located in Baldwin County.

B. This Agreement imposes certain protocols, procedures and obligations upon Law Enforcement entities or agencies hereby authorized to use State of Alabama and Baldwin County Commission licensed radio channels held by the Alabama Department of Homeland Security and the Baldwin County Commission, by and through the Baldwin County Communications Information Systems Department.

Section 2. Authority:

Participation in this Agreement and permission to use the Baldwin County Interoperability P25 700 MHz or Law Enforcement Interoperability Channels by Federal, State, County and Local entities or agencies is hereby authorized by the Baldwin County Commission, Baldwin County Sheriff and Local Municipalities and Chiefs of Police, and shall be managed by the Baldwin County Communications & Information Systems Department ("CIS") and the Baldwin County Commission Interoperability Communications Advisory Committee, as authorized by the Baldwin County Commission.

Federal Agencies are permitted access to interoperability channels, as authorized by 47 CFR 2.102 (c) and 2.103. Federal Agencies may execute this Agreement and shall adhere to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

Section 3. Applicability:

A. This Agreement authorizes the use of Baldwin County Interoperability channels and radio frequencies by Law Enforcement Agencies, as such agencies are defined by the Baldwin County Commission, in its discretion, based on recommendations by the Baldwin County Interoperability Advisory Committee.

Law Enforcement Agencies include the following organizations:

B. The above list is not all inclusive, and other Law Enforcement related emergency responder agencies may be added as determined by the Baldwin County Commission, in its discretion, based on recommendations of the Baldwin County Commission Interoperability Communications Advisory Committee.

C. This Agreement authorizes the use of State and Baldwin County Commission licensed frequencies for the purpose of coordination between emergency first responder agencies and management of those resources. Such coordination may occur during interagency operations, en-route travel response or on-scene incident communications in accordance with an Incident Communications Plan.

Section 4. Understandings:

A. The Baldwin County Commission by and through the Baldwin County Communication & Information Systems ("CIS") department shall do the following:

1. Manage and maintain proper licenses for the use of the interoperability frequencies.
2. Manage and maintain an accurate database of Federal, State, County and Local government entities or agencies that have accepted and signed this Agreement or are otherwise approved to use the System.
3. Issue any talk groups, channels and subscriber ID's that will be used on the Countywide Interoperability radio system.

4. The Baldwin County Commission shall have the authority to monitor proper usage of the interoperability talk groups and channels, although the Baldwin County Commission and its departments, committees, or employees shall not be liable for any content or misuse of the System.
5. Maintain the systems operations, functionality and upgrades, as deemed necessary for optimal performance of the Baldwin County 700 MHz radio system.

B. Agencies shall do the following:

1. Participate in Baldwin County communications planning for countywide communications interoperability as may be required by the Baldwin County Commission, by and through CIS.
2. Manage the proper usage of interoperability frequencies, talk groups and channels by its employees, ensuring compliance with any Federal, State, County or Local laws, ordinances and rules.
3. Utilize the interoperability frequencies, talk groups and channels hereby authorized for their intended purpose of coordination between emergency first responders.
4. Use the interoperability frequencies, talk groups and channels for on-scene incident communications, as established by the on-scene Incident Commander and governed by any Federal, State, County or Local laws, ordinances or rules.
5. Implement radio communications procedures consistent with National Incident Management Systems (NIMS) and Incident Command Systems (ICS) including:
 - a. Use of “plain language” without 10-codes or agency specific codes/jargon.
 - b. Use the calling protocol: “Agency/Unit Call-sign, this is Agency/Unit Call-sign, rather than “Call-sign to Call-sign”.

Example: “Spanish Fort PD 401 to Baldwin Sheriff B1”

6. Ensure that agency mobile, portable and base radios intended for use by the agency for interoperability communications on the 700 MHz radio system are properly configured for the proper interoperability frequencies, talk groups and channels, as outlined by the Baldwin County Commission by and through CIS. This means that the Law Enforcement Interoperability frequencies and trunking talk groups would be added to the agencies daily frequencies used by that entity as assigned.
7. A. The assigned talk groups/channels for Interoperability Communications will be assigned by Baldwin County Commission by and through CIS.

The designated channels are as follows:

1. BC OPS 1
2. BC OPS 2
3. BC OPS 3

The above County Operations Channels will be required by any agency utilizing the County 700 MHz System. These channels will be programmed in ALL mobile and portable radio equipment for interoperability with first responder organizations within Baldwin County.

B. The below listed channels will be required for all Law Enforcement for interoperability incidents related to Law Enforcement only operations.

1. BC LAW 1 (*reserved for Vehicle Chase, Be On the Lookout and Crimes in progress notices.*)
2. BC LAW 2
3. BC LAW 3
4. BC LAW 4

Section 5. Prioritization of Interoperability Frequencies, Talk groups and Channels:

A. Interoperability communications will be assigned by the following order of precedence:

1. Emergency or urgent operations involving imminent danger to life. Note: Agencies involved in incidents of this nature may (if radio consoles allow) make a **temporary** patch with their main channel to BC LAW 1, if additional outside resources are requested. This patch will allow responding units and other Agencies real time information sharing for the life threatening event.
2. Disaster or extreme emergency operations requiring extensive interoperability and inter-agency communications.
3. Special events, generally pre-planned in nature.
4. Joint training exercises.
5. Interagency and en-route communications.

B. Agencies mutually agree:

1. Agencies agree that their mutual interests will be furthered by continued coordination among entities, agencies, the Baldwin County Commission Interoperability Advisory Committee and the Baldwin County Communications & Information Systems Department.
2. Agencies understand and agree that the assigned Law Enforcement Interoperability talk groups, channels and frequencies are to be used only in an emergency or scheduled event and not for day to day communications within their agency.

3. Agencies and the Baldwin County Commission agree that the Law Enforcement Interoperability talk groups, channels and frequencies will be controlled at all times by the Baldwin County Commission.
4. (a) Agencies and the Baldwin County Commission agree that this Agreement may be cancelled or terminated, with or without cause, at any time, by the Baldwin County Commission, by written notice to the other parties or by subsequent agreements. In that event, the parties shall have no further rights, duties or obligations hereunder.

(b) Any Agency may, by written notice to the Baldwin County Commission, withdraw from this Agreement and cease use of the System. The Baldwin County Commission shall have the authority, with or without cause, to terminate, suspend or expel any Agency from the use of the System, in its discretion, based on a recommendation by the Baldwin County Interoperability Advisory Committee. In either of those events, this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as to the remaining agencies.

Section 6. Procedures:

All procedures herein comply with Federal Department of Homeland Security, Incident Management Policies for First Responder Organizations and the Baldwin County Emergency Management, Tactical Communications Plan, as mandated by the State of Alabama.

A. Request for Assistance:

1. Any Law Enforcement Agency in Baldwin County, whether Federal, State, County or Municipal can request mutual aid from each other utilizing the designated Law Interoperability radio channels, known as, **BC Law 1 through 4**. (*BC LAW 1 reserved as stated above in "Section 7.B.1).*)
2. The requesting agency may request mutual aid via telephone from their dispatch center to the mutual aid agency's dispatch center. Agency may do a direct radio patch, if for protection of life incidents, but this is at the discretion of the agency.
3. The requesting agency will designate the Law Interoperability channel to be utilized for the mutual aid request.
4. All responding units will utilize the designated Law Interoperability channel for the duration of the mutual aid mission.
5. The requesting agency's dispatch center will monitor all radio traffic and handle requests from all officers operating on the Law Interoperability channel. The requesting agency shall assume Incident Command and follow their procedures as needed for the event.

6. The Incident Commander for the requesting agency will notify the respective dispatch centers when the mutual aid request is completed and the Law Interoperability channel is clear for the next mission.
7. Units will announce when they are switching back to their agency's primary dispatch channel.

B. Request for Radio Channel Patches:

1. In the event multiple first responder agencies from Federal, State, County or Municipal agencies within or outside Baldwin County request a mutual aid assistance, all radio patches will be handled by either Baldwin County Sheriff's Office or Baldwin County E911 centers.
Example: Sheriff's Swat patched to South Baldwin Special Response Team.
2. All patches will be made operational and non-operational by the Incident Commander for the entity or agency requesting the mutual aid assistance.
3. Radio channel patches will only be made in the event an already existing mutual aid interoperability channel is not available to handle the event.
4. The communications center that is requested to make a radio channel patch will monitor the radio traffic, as well as, the dispatch center for the agency requesting the channel patch.
Requesting agency shall be the lead agency for the incident

Section 7. Waiver of Liability.

All entities or agencies which are a party to this Agreement or utilize the System or participate in any way with the System hereby agree to hold harmless and waive any claims for damages or liability against Baldwin County, the Baldwin County Commission, and its or their Commissioners, officers, supervisors, departments, committees, employees and agents (referred to collectively in this Section 7 as the "Baldwin County Commission") related to the Services provided by the Baldwin County Commission pursuant to or related to this Agreement or the operation, management and maintenance of the System.

Section 8. Authorization for Use by Additional Agencies.

Subject to approval by the Baldwin County Commission, additional law enforcement agencies may be authorized to use the System upon execution of this Agreement or other documentation approved by the Baldwin County Commission.

Section 9. Sharing of Talk Groups, Etc.

Any participating agencies, talk groups, channels and subscriber ID's will not be made available to any other requesting entity or agency with the approval of CIS, based on a request by the participating agency.

Section 10.

The Baldwin County Commission reserves the right to change or amend any policies, procedures or rules related to the use of the System, and/or any provision of this Agreement, as deemed necessary, in its discretion, with or without the consent or approval of the entities or agencies. Such change or amendment shall become effective immediately upon its adoption or approval by the Baldwin County Commission.
