AGENCY AGREEMENT

The Baldwin County Commission hereby authorizes the Alabama Secretary of State to act as its agent for the purposes of paying postage necessary for the mailing of certain notices to voters as required by Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-30, and collecting reimbursements from the State Election Expenses Account associated with compliance with Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-31. The County Commission understands that the Secretary of State will be paying postage on the voter notifications required by Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-30(a), for which the Commission will be obligated to reimburse the Secretary of State by this agreement and that such reimbursement shall occur from monies the County is entitled to for such costs from the State Election Expenses Account pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-31.

The County Commission also agrees that the business reply mail account fee and business reply mail postage charges will remain its responsibility for which it may be reimbursed by the State of Alabama under the normal operation of Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-31.
