**SUPPORTING THE REQUEST BY THE CITY OF GULF SHORES TO RECLASSIFY
ALL OR PORTIONS OF E. 20th STREET, DOLPHIN AVENUE AND E. 15th STREET**

WHEREAS, the City of Gulf Shores is requesting the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) change the functional classifications of the following roads:

- Reclassify E. 20th Avenue from Gulf Shores Parkway to E. 2nd Street from a local road to a minor arterial;
- Reclassify Dolphin Avenue from E. 2nd Street to E. 15th Avenue from a local road to a major collector; and
- Reclassify E. 15th Avenue from E. 2nd Street to Dolphin Avenue from a local road to a major collector;

WHEREAS, ALDOT has requested a Resolution from the Baldwin County Commission supporting and endorsing the requested reclassifications;

WHEREAS, ALDOT has reviewed the proposed reclassifications and believes that the requested changes are in the best interest of the County and the City of Gulf Shores as the entities work to accommodate traffic in South Alabama;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that we support the request by the City of Gulf Shores to reclassify E. 20th Avenue, Dolphin Avenue and E. 15th Avenue in the manner set forth above.

The foregoing resolution was adopted and approved on the 16th day of December, 2014, by the Baldwin County Commission.




