**RESOLUTION #2015-125**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION REQUESTING THE EASTERN SHORE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FUND A PROJECT TO INSTALL SIGNAGE AT THE I-10 AND STATE ROAD 59 INTERCHANGE IN LOXLEY NOTIFYING MOTORISTS OF THE BALDWIN BEACH EXPRESS FOR WHICH THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION WILL PROVIDE THE 20% LOCAL MATCH

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission ("County") is a member of the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and

WHEREAS, Federal funding is available through the MPO for Long Range Transportation Plan projects; and

WHEREAS, Federal law requires a twenty percent (20%) local match for projects utilizing Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, County desires to install signage at the I-10 and State Road 59 Interchange in Loxley notifying motorists of the Baldwin Beach Express (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated total Project cost is \$18,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the estimated local match for the Project is \$3,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution from a sponsoring local government committing the sponsoring government to providing the 20% local match for project funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that we request the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization fund the signage at the I-10 and State Road 59 Interchange in Loxley notifying motorists of the Baldwin Beach Express and we commit to providing the local match for Project amounting to 20% of the total Project cost.
