A RESOLUTION OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION REQUESTING THE EASTERN SHORE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FUND A PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK ON GAYFER ROAD EXTENSION FROM MEADOWBROOK SUBDIVISION TO BISHOP ROAD IN FAIRHOPE FOR WHICH THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION WILL PROVIDE HALF OF THE 20% LOCAL MATCH

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission ("County") and the City of Fairhope ("City") are members of the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and

WHEREAS, Federal funding is available through the MPO for Transportation Improvement Program projects; and

WHEREAS, Federal law requires a twenty percent (20%) local match for projects utilizing Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, County and City desire the construction of a sidewalk on Gayfer Road Extension from Meadowbrook Subdivision to Bishop Road in Fairhope (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated total Project cost is \$132,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the estimated local match for the Project is \$26,400.00; and

WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution from sponsoring local governments committing the sponsoring governments to providing the 20% local match for Project funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that we request the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization fund the Project to construct a sidewalk on Gayfer Road Extension from Meadowbrook Subdivision to Bishop Road in Fairhope and we commit to providing half of the local match for Project amounting to 10% of the total Project cost.
