Composition of Commission appointees: One (1) member representing B.C. Bar Association, One (1) member is Presiding Circuit Judge, One (1) member representing Baldwin County Commission, One (1) member representing B.C. Mayors' Association and One (1) member representing B.C. Legislative Delegation

One (1) member appointed by Baldwin County Commission: must reside in territory of 28th Judicial Circuit [Baldwin County], cannot hold a public office and cannot hold an official position in any political party.

Term of each member is Six (6) years.
