

FORT MORGAN PLANNING AND ZONING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

General Board Information:

Composed of the following members: Two members appointed by the Baldwin County Commission from a list of not less than four nominations by the Fort Morgan Civic Association, Inc.; and three members appointed by the Fort Morgan Civic Association, Inc.

All members shall be residents and registered voters in the Fort Morgan District. All members shall serve a term of four years and may be reappointed to succeeding terms. Members shall serve until a replacement is appointed and qualified. Any vacancy on the committee shall be filled by the original appointing authority. Members shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses in the performance of their duties by the county. Any member may be removed for cause by his or her original appointing authority.

The committee shall include the following non-voting ex-officio members: (1) The Mayor of Gulf Shores, or his or her designee. (2) The member of the House of Representatives of the State Legislature representing all or a majority of the district. (3) The member of the Baldwin County Commission whose district includes all or a majority of the district.

The purpose of the planning and zoning advisory committee shall be to make recommendation to the Baldwin County Planning and Zoning Commission concerning any proposed changes to zoning ordinances or regulations or the master plan, or variances thereto, related to the Fort Morgan Zoning District.
