You are hereby commanded to notify Thomas J. Nowood
P. Hooney and J. Holman that at a Special Term, 1907 of the
Circuit Court of said County, a judgment was rendered against

Indictment for disposing of mortgaged
property. July 26th 1907

It appearing to the Court that the said Thomas
Nowood together with P. Hooney and J. Holman agreed
to pay the State of Alabama the sum of One Hundred
and fifty Dollars unless the said Thomas J. Nowood
appeared at this Term of the Court to answer in this
Case, and the said Thomas J. Nowood having failed to
appear, it is therefore ordered that the State of Alabama
for the use of Baldwin County, recover of the said Thomas
J. Nowood, P. Hooney and J. Holman, on said
undertaking, the sum of One Hundred and fifty Dollars
unless they appear at the next Term of this Court and
show cause why this judgment should not be made absolute.
You will, therefore, by giving a copy hereof, notify the said
Thomas J. Nowood, P. Hooney and J. Holman that the said
judgment will be made absolute against them at the
next term of said Court unless they then appear
and show cause against the same.
