The Condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bounden Herman Schroeder hath the day of the date hereof, before the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baldwin, prayed an Attachment at the suit of himself against the estate of above named Kallman Papoy

for the sum of One Hundred Forty three & 55/100 Dollars, and hath obtained the same returnable to the Circuit Court of Baldwin, on the 3th Monday after the 4th Monday of March 1915.

Now, if the said Herman Schroeder shall prosecute said Attachment to effect, and pay to the said Kallman Papoy all such damages as he may sustain by the wrongful or vexatious suing out thereof, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.


To the Sheriff of Baldwin County,
