**REPEALING RESOLUTION #2005-100 OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION AND
DISSOLVING THE BALDWIN COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES MEDICAL ADVISORY BOARD.**

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board, hereafter referred to as the "Advisory Board," was established on July 5, 2005, by Baldwin County Commission Resolution #2005-100 (**Exhibit A**) with the purpose of to provide advisory recommendations to the Commission related to the operation of medical transportation services in the unincorporated Baldwin County areas; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board no longer serves the purpose or scope of which it was originally intended; and

WHEREAS, Section 5. (a) of Baldwin County Commission Resolution #2005-100 states that "The Commission may, at any time, terminate the Board by repealing this resolution;" now therefore

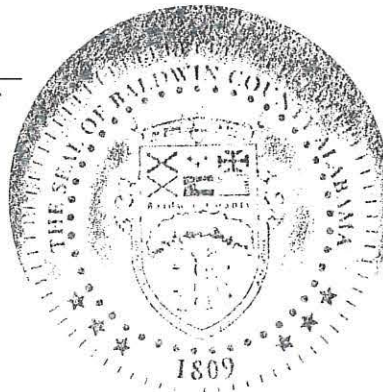

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, As follows:

**BALDWIN COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
ADVISORY BOARD**

Section 1. Definitions.

(a) Commission: Baldwin County Commission, the honorable county governing body of Baldwin County, Alabama.

(b) Board: Baldwin County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board.

Section 2. Intent.

That, upon the adoption of *Resolution #2005-99 of the Baldwin County Commission*, there is hereby established the Board to serve only in an advisory capacity to make advisory recommendations to the Commission related to the operation of Ambulances, or other related Medical Transportation Services, for entities providing such service in the unincorporated areas of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Section 3. Composition.

(a) The Board shall be composed of twelve (12) members, of which each member shall be a qualified elector in and an actual resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Commission, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission, for a term of four years each. All members shall serve without compensation.

(b) The twelve (12) member Board shall be composed of the following:

- 1) One (1) member who serves as Director of the Baldwin County Emergency Communication District (911) Board.
- 2) One (1) member who serves as Director of the Baldwin County Emergency Management Agency.
- 3) One (1) member who is the Coroner of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 4) One (1) member who is designated by the South Baldwin Regional Medical Center.
- 5) One (1) member who is designated by the North Baldwin Infirmary.
- 6) One (1) member who is designated by Thomas Hospital.
- 7) One (1) member who is representative of the Fire Departments in North Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 8) One (1) member who is representative of the Fire Departments in Central Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 9) One (1) member who is representative of the Fire Departments in South Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 10) One (1) member who is representative of the Fire Departments in Eastern Shore Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 11) One (1) member who is representative of search & rescue squads/units in Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 12) One (1) member who is representative of law enforcement in Baldwin County, Alabama.

(c) In the event of a vacancy on the Board, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the Commission. No limitations shall exist regarding the re-appointment of incumbent members of the Board, except as set forth herein. Furthermore, the Commission may remove any member of the Board for cause.
