**RESOLUTION #2024-021
OF THE
BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR
GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES USING REVENUE REPLACEMENT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, Baldwin County, Alabama, (the "County") has received American Rescue Plan Act fiscal recovery funds ("ARPA funds") and is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the final rule issued by Treasury on January 6, 2022, the County has duly elected to take the standard allowance of Revenue Replacement funds equal to \$10,000,000 of its ARPA funds ("ARPA revenue replacement funds"); and

WHEREAS, the County may use revenue replacement funds to cover the costs that it typically bears to provide government services; and

WHEREAS, one of the costs the County typically bears to provide these services is the maintenance of and improvements to government facilities; and


WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission ("the Commission") has determined that the purchase and installation of video security technology and installation of new, more secure doors in the Reappraisal office building located in Robertsedale, Alabama is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of revenue replacement funds; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that expenditure of ARPA revenue replacement funds for this project is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

1. The County hereby conditionally allocates up to \$13,026.27 of its ARPA revenue replacement funds to cover part or all of the eligible costs of the Revenue Department's professional and construction services for proximity access and video security technology on four exterior doors at the Reappraisal building in Robertsedale, Alabama.
2. ARPA funds will not be obligated or expended for an eligible government service project prior to the Commission's adoption of a resolution authorizing the terms and conditions of the agreements after such determination is made by Vision Security Technologies.
