WHEREAS, Lieutenant Anderson served as POD Supervisor, Commissary Accountant, Visitation Supervisor, Intake Officer, Records Clerk, Postal Officer, and Food Services Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Anderson was promoted through the ranks of Corporal, Sergeant, Staff Sergeant, and reached the rank of Lieutenant in 2019; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Anderson has served under two Sheriffs of Baldwin County: Sheriff James B. Johnson and Sheriff Huey Hoss Mack; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Anderson has positively impacted the lives of many people incarcerated in the Baldwin County Corrections Center; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Anderson has led and trained numerous Corrections Officers on the proper policies and procedures to ensure the job was done correctly and those in the care and custody of the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office were treated with respect; and

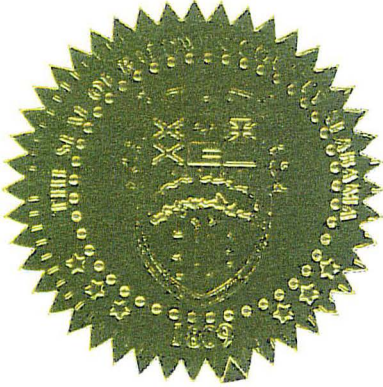
