**GRANTING ECOVERY, LLC AN EXTENSION OF ITS SALES AND USE TAX
EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2024.**

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission granted a tax abatement to Ecovery LLC on April 5, 2022; and

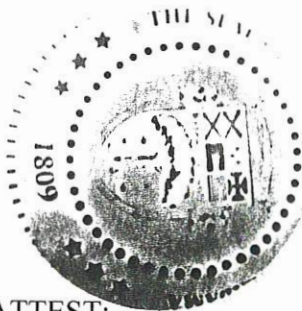
WHEREAS, the Tax Abatement Agreement between the Baldwin County Commission (the Granting Authority), and Ecovery LLC (the Company), was amended on April 18, 2023, to include an increase in capital investment in the tax abatements granted to Ecovery LLC due to a major addition to their existing facility; and

WHEREAS, due to planning and zoning timelines, equipment procurement supply chain delays and the Company’s Sales and Use Tax Certificate of Exemption expiration date of January 1, 2024, the Company has requested an extension from the Alabama Department of Revenue of the Sales and Use Tax Certificate of Exemption until December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Company has requested an amendment to the agreed upon active tax abatement between the Granting Authority and the Company, referencing the active tax abatement dated April 5, 2022; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that the amended agreement modifies the Tax Abatement Agreement dated April 5th, 2022, between the Baldwin County Commission and Ecovery LLC, its successors, and assigns, to include an extension of the expired Sales and Use Tax Certificate of Exemption to the dated 31st day of December 2024.
