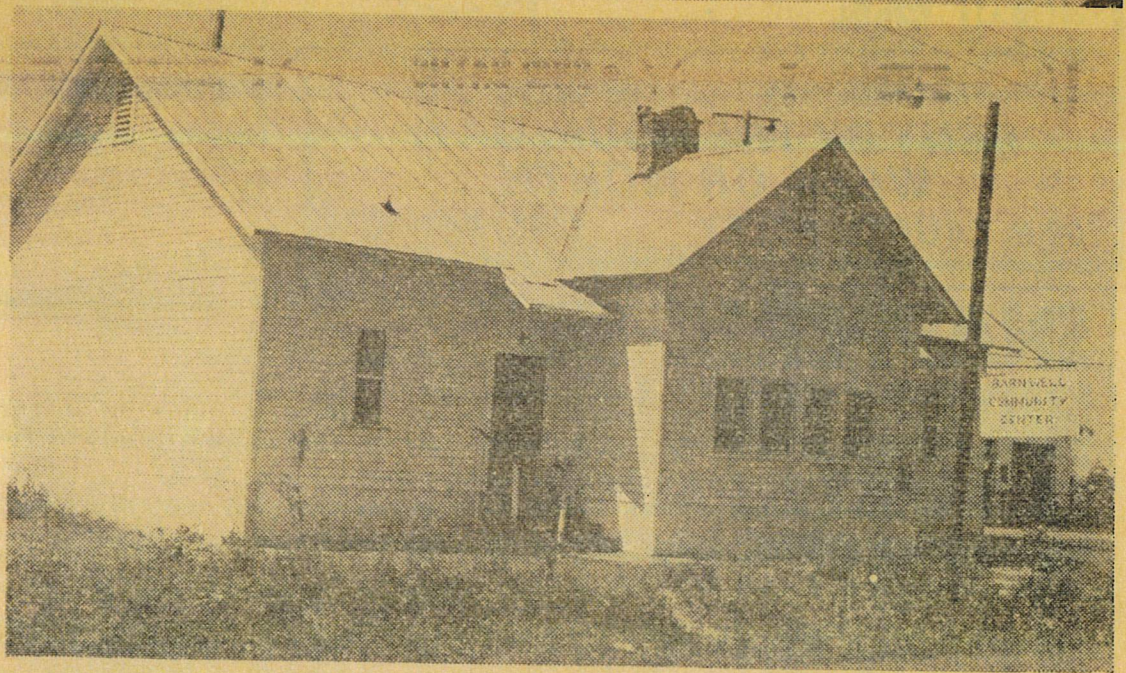




BARNWELL LANDMARK — A group of students poses in front of the old Barnwell School, top photo, sometime before the hurricane of 1916, which demolished the structure. The schoolhouse/community center, bottom photo, was constructed in 1918 by the volunteer labor of local residents. A recent attempt to construct a more modern facility at the site was quelled by longtime residents who were both

educated and entertained in the one-room, frame structure, and who consider the building to be a community landmark. Instead, the building, which suffered severe damage caused by Hurricane Frederic and a fire, was repainted and remodeled and is still in use for community activities.
