## OFFICIAL ABSENTEE BALLOT

Submitted to an election of the qualified voters of Alabama, to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 1958. Following the proposed amendments is printed the word "Yes" and immediately under that is printed the word "No." The choice of the elector shall be indicated by a cross mark (X) made by him or under his direction opposite the word expressing his desire.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 1

Shall the following be adopted as an Amendment to the Constitution of Alabama?

"The Legislature shall not pass a special, private, or local law changing the form of government of Lauderdale County or of any city, town, village, district or other such political subdivision of the county, or abridge the term of any elected officer thereof, by the abolition of his office otherwise, unless the operation of such law shall be approved by a vote of the duly qualified electors of such county, city, town, village, district, or other political subdivision of the county, at an election held for such purpose, in the manner prescribed by such law."

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2

Shall the following be adopted as an Amendment to the Constitution of Alabama?

"The provisions of an act of the Legislature approved on the seventeenth day of June 1957 relative to the powers of Marion County to provide schools and other improvements, being Act No. 29, H. B. 107, 1957 Regular Session, are hereby ratified, validated, and confirmed, any provisions of the Constitution of Alabama as amended to the contrary notwithstanding."
