Crouch, County Game Warden, who, being duly sworn according to law, doth depose and say that he has probable cause for believing, and does believe, that William Kuse did use a fish trap in a stream in this state and the wings of said trap so used did occupy more than one half the width of the stream in which it was operated or located, when the said stream is at low watermark, and that said offense has been committed in said County and State by said William Kuse within the past 12 months and before the making of this affidavit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
