The State of Alabama

Baldwin County Circuit Court Fall Term 1910

The Grand Jury of said County charge that, before the finding of this indictment, Robert Cox with intent to injure or defraud E. S. Nelson his employer entered into a written contract with the said E. S. Nelson on to wit Dec 27th 1910 for the performance of service as turpentine farm laborer to chip or pull turpentine boxes for said employer E. S. Nelson and bound himself by contract to said E. S. Nelson as his employer and thereby by so contracting and agreeing with said E. S. Nelson as his employer, obtained from E. S. Nelson his said employer thirty one dollars in money, goods, and chattels or other personal property, or of the value of thirty one dollars with intent to injure or defraud his said employer E. S. Nelson, and without just cause and without refunding such money or paying for such property, refused or failed to perform such acts of service

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama
