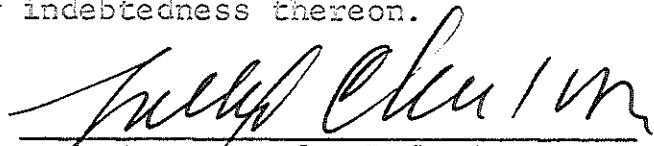

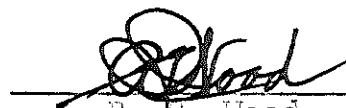
Comes the Defendant and for answer to the complaint, states that there is failure of consideration for said promissory note and the Defendant denies any indebtedness thereon.

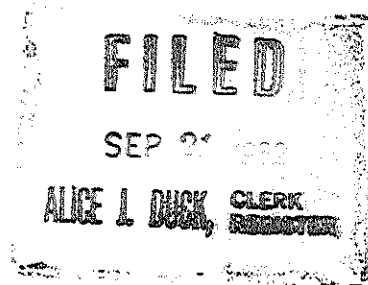
