COUNT I

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE AND 08/100 (\$2,651.08) DOLLARS due by promissory note made by him on, to-wit, the 3rd day of January, 1962, and payable ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) on the 15th day of February, 1962, and payments of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) per month to be made on the 15th of each month until the total indebtedness is paid. And Defendant, as part of the consideration in said note, agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection thereof in case suit should be brought for the collection thereof, which Plaintiff further claims in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY AND 22/100 (\$530.22) DOLLARS, together with the interest on said note.

COUNT II


COUNT III


