The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Eight hundred ninty-seven and 30/100 Dollars (\$897.30), as damages for that on, to-wit, the 11th day of October, 1961, the Plaintiff's motor vehicle was being lawfully operated upon a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, on U. S. 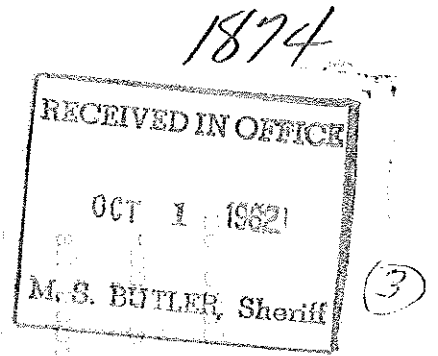
