



In and by terms of said note, the Plaintiff hereof had the option to declare the whole indebtedness due and payable on the default of any one note.

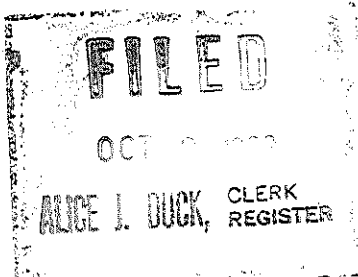



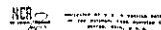
