I am also personally acquainted with the land described in the bill of complaint of T. J. Klumpp, Complainant, vs. John B. Watkins, et al., Respondents, now pending in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Equity, and being No. 664.

I know that no suit is pending to test the title of the Complainant, T. J. Klumpp to, his interest in, or his rights of possession of the said lands, being described as All of Section 29, Township 5 South, Range 3 East, in Baldwin County, Alabama.

I have been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, since the year 1907, during which period I have lived and spent a greater part of the time at Silverhill, in Baldwin County, Alabama. looked after by Mr. Oscar Johnson. Mr. Tallberg retained title to these lands until some in 1909, when he sold them to Gustaf Burklund, and that the Burklands, in turn, sold them to Arvid Bjork and Louise Bjork, who, in turn, conveyed them to Walter F. Lovell, and then Walter F. Lovell conveyed it to his brother, Elmer V. Lovell, who in turn, conveyed said lands to T. J. Klumpp, the Complainant; that the said Elmer V.
