This cause, coming on to be heard at this Term, was submitted upon the Bill of Complaint, decree pro confesso and the testimony as noted by the Register; and, upon consideration thereof, the Court is of opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

IT IS THEREFORE Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court, that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and the Complainant is forever divorced from the Defendant.

It is further ordered that the said CAROLINE GRACE BREWTON, be, and she is hereby permitted to again contract marriage, upon the payment of the costs of Court in this cause.

It is further ordered, that the said CAROLINE GRACE BREWTON, pay the costs herein taxed, for which execution may issue, and if such execution is returned "no property found," then execution for such costs may be issued against the said JASPER S. BREWTON

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said CAROLINE GRACE BREWTON shall not again marry except to said JASPER S. BREWTON until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days she shall not marry again except to said JASPER S. BREWTON during the said pendency of appeal.

TO THE HON. F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF
BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA. SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes CAROLINE GRACE BREWTON, your complainant, and
humbly complaining against JASPER S. BREWTON, respectfully
represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST

That your complainant, CAROLINE GRACE BREWTON, and the
said JASPER S. BREWTON, defendant, are each over the age of
twenty-one years and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama,
and have been for more than five years next preceding the
filing of this bill of complaint.

SECOND

That your complainant and the defendant were married
in the city of Fernandina, Florida in April, 1927.

THIRD

That your complainant and the said defendant lived
together as husband and wife until, to-wit, the summer of
1935 from which time your complainant has lived separate and
apart from the bed and board of the said defendant and your
complainant has not received any support from the said defen-
dant for more than two years next preceding the filing of this
her bill of complaint; that since the marriage of your complain-
ant and the said defendant he has become addicted to habitual
drunkenness and for the past six years he has been under the
influence of intoxicating liquors on an average of at least
twice a month and would stay in such condition for several
days at the time and while under the influence of intoxicating
liquors would curse and abuse your complainant and while in
such a state would lie in bed three or four days at the time
under the influence of intoxicating liquors.

FOURTH

That there was born to the said union one child whose name is Tilda Jane Brewton, thirteen years of age and who is now in the care and custody of your complainant.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

WHEREFORE, your complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said JASPER S. BREWTON a party defendant to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time prescribed by law and under the penalties of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

And your complainant further prays that your Honor will give and grant unto her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the said complainant and the said defendant. And your complainant further prays that your Honor will grant unto her the right to remarry; and your complainant prays for such other, further and different relief as she may be entitled to receive in the premises.
