COMPLAINT

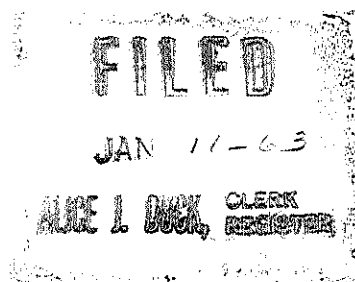
