

C O M P L A I N T

COUNT I

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of ONE HUNDRED NINE & 10/100 (\$109.10) DOLLARS, plus interest thereon since maturity, due by promissory note made by him on, to-wit, the 24th day of January, 1958, and payable in eleven installments of TWELVE & 10/100 (\$12.10) DOLLARS, payable on the 27th day of each consecutive month, beginning the 27th day of February, 1958, and the balance of TWELVE & 30/100 (\$12.30) DOLLARS payable on the 27th day of January, 1959; and the Plaintiff avers that the Defendant defaulted in the payment due on the 27th day of May, 1958, and the Plaintiff, under the terms of said note, declared the entire unpaid balance due and payable;

And the Plaintiff avers that in said note and as a part of the consideration thereof, the Defendant has expressly waived his rights to claim personal property as exempt to him under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama and agreed to pay an attorney's fee for the collection thereof and the Plaintiff hereby claims the further sum of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) as such attorney's fee.


