COUNT I.



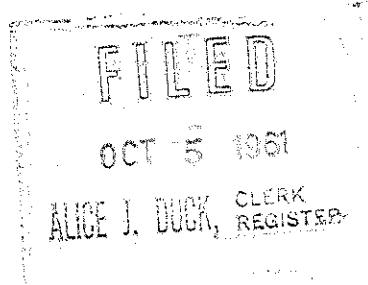
COUNT III.


