Plaintiff claims of Defendant the sum of ONE-HUNDRED NINE and SIXTY-THREE ONE-HUNDREDTHS (\$109.63) DOLLARS and that on to-wit March 29, 1961 Defendant entered into an agreement to purchase a Hi Fi Stereo for a total price of \$338.10 payable at \$16.10 per month beginning May 5, 1961, that the said contract provided that upon default in the said payment Plaintiff was empowered to take possession, without notice, of the said Hi Fi Stereo and sell the same at private sale, the proceeds of such sale to be applied toward the balance then due.

Plaintiff further alleges that Defendant defaulted in the said payment leaving a balance due of \$299.63, that Plaintiff took possession of the said Hi Fi Stereo, and that he sold the same for \$190.00 which sum was applied to the balance of \$299.63 on to-wit August 1, 1961 leaving a balance of \$109.63 due under the terms of the said contract.

Plaintiff further alleges that the said contract provided for the payment of a reasonable attorney's fee and that \$25.00 is a reasonable attorney's fee, and that the said contract contains a waive of exemption whereof Plaintiff claims benefit.

Plaintiff claims of Defendant the sum of ONE-HUNDRED NINE and SIXTY-THREE ONE-HUNDREDTHS (\$109.63) DOLLARS and that on to-wit March 29, 1961 Defendant entered into an agreement to purchase a Hi Fi Stereo for a total price of \$338.10 payable at \$16.10 per month beginning May 5, 1961, that the said contract provided that upon default in the said payment Plaintiff was empowered to take possession, without notice, of the said Hi Fi Stereo and sell the same at private sale, the proceeds of such sale to be applied toward the balance then due.

Plaintiff further alleges that Defendant defaulted in the said payment leaving a balance due of \$299.63, that Plaintiff took possession of the said Hi Fi Stereo, and that he sold the same for \$190.00 which sum was applied to the balance of \$299.63 on to-wit August 1, 1961 leaving a balance of \$109.63 due under the terms of the said contract.

Plaintiff further alleges that the said contract provided for the payment of a reasonable attorney's fee and that \$25.00 is a reasonable attorney's fee, and that the said contract contains a waive of exemption whereof Plaintiff claims benefit.
