BILL OF COMPLAINT

TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN
COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN CHANCERY SITTING:

PART ONE

Your complainant, Eva Moore, respectfully shows to Your Honor that she is over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident of the State of Alabama, residing in Jefferson County therein; that the respondent, John Standke, is also over the age of twenty-one years and is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, being a resident of the City of Chicago, Illinois.

PART TWO

Your complainant further avers:

1. That she is in the actual, peaceable possession, claiming to own the same in her own right, the following described real estate in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5), Township Eight (8) South of Range Four (4) East.....

2. That the respondent, John Standke, is reputed to own the same, or some part thereof, or some interest therein, or to hold some lien or encumbrance thereon, and no suit is pending to enforce or test the validity of such title, claim or encumbrance and complainant brings this suit in equity to settle the title to such lands and to clear up all doubts or disputes concerning the same.

3. Your complainant calls upon the respondent, John Standke, to set forth and specify his title, claim, interest or

encumbrance, and how and by what instrument the same is derived and created.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your complainant prays that Your Honor will direct that the Register of this Court make out and superintend the appropriate order of publication to the non-resident defendant, John Standke, commanding him within thirty (30) days after the period specified in the order of publication, to appear before Your Honor in this honorable Court, then and there to answer all and singular the premises, and to stand to and abide such order and decree therein as to this honorable Court shall seem meet; and your complainant shall ever pray, etc.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

And your complainant would further pray that, upon the final hearing of this cause, Your Honor will make and enter a decree that your complainant is the owner of said real estate hereinbefore described, and that the respondent, John Standke, has no right, title, interest, lien or encumbrance in, to or upon the same, or any part thereof, and that your complainant shall have such other and further relief in the premises as may be just and equitable.
