And now comes your Complainant, HELEN B. SMYDER, and humbly complaining against the Respondent, BUHNS SMYDER, respectfully represents and shows unto your monor and this Monorable Court as follows:

- 1. That your Complainant and the Respondent are both residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age.
- 2. That your Complainant and the Respondent were married at Athore, in Escambia County, Alabama, on September 5th, 1939, and lived together as husband and wife only two days, in Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 3. That the Respondent is a man of high temperament; that immediately after their marriage therespondent began cursing, abusing and threatening the Complainant and often threatened to do violence to her person; that his conduct was such as to give her every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him as his wife, he would carry out his threats and do violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHAREFORE, the premises considered, Complainant prays that your Honor will, by proper process, make the said BURNS SEYDER party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same, within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the gractice of this Konorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, your honor will give and grant unto her a decree of absolute divorce, forever barring the bonds of antrimony existing between her and the Respondent, BUR-S SIVER, and that a further decree be entered restoring to your vorplainant her former name, Helen Brown; Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will over prays.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon the original Bill of Complaint, Answer and Waiver of the Respondent, and Proof as noted by the Register, and the Court, after due consideration, is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant be restored her maiden name, HELEN BROWN.

My name is Helen B. Snyder. I live about eight miles from Bay Minette, in Raldwin County, Alabama. I am the Complainant in the case of Holen B. Snyder vs. Burns Snyder.

Burns Snyder and I were married near Atmore, in Escambia County, Alabama, on September 5th, 1939; I had been around the Respondent for only a short time before we married. He is a man of high temperament; that immediately after our marriage, he became dissatisfied, cursed, abused and threatened me and often threatened to do violence to my person; that on one or two occasions while I was in the car with him, he threatened my life and said that he was going to wreck the car and kill me. His conduct was such that it was absolutely impossible for me to live with him, and I had to leave him, and have since leaving him, been living with my folks and they have had to support me. Burns Snyder has contributed nothing toward my support since we were married. On account of his threats and abuses, I was afraid to live with him as his wife, and his conduct was such that I had every reasonable apprehension to believe and did actually believe that if I should live with him as his wife, he would carry out his threats and do further actual violence to my person, which would necessarily endanger my life and health. My name before marriage was Helen Brown.

AUGUSTINE JOYMAR, A WITHESS FOR THE COMPLAINANT, BAING FIRST DULY SWOWN, DEPOSES AND SAYS:

My name is Augustine Joymer. I live about one mile from where Helen B. Snyder lives. I am personally acquainted with Helen B. Snyder and Burns Snyder. I know that Burns Snyder is a men of high temperament and at times when mad, is unable to control himself. I have had occasion to see Helen B. Snyder almost daily and know that she has not lived with Burns Snyder and that Burns Snyder has contributed absolutely nothing toward her support. Knowing Burns Snyder as I do and his tempoerament and having been around him when he was mad, I know that it was absolutely im-
