

Mandamus and not appeal is remedy where Court refuses to allow proof that parties to a divorce suit were never married; proof of marriage is necessary to support claim for alimony. 168 Ala 183 (52 So. 61)

However this last case applies to a decree and not to a matter pendente lite but I cite it because it has probative value in deciding the above motion.

Without this affidavit there isn't even prima facie proof upon which the alimony pendente lite and attorney's fees can rest.
