TO HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

And now comes your Complainant, MARIA COOPER, and humbly complaining against the Respondent, SAMUEL J. COOPER, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST: That both your Complainant and Respondent are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age; that the Respondent is concealing himself so that papers cannot be served upon him; that his address is unknown and, although inquiries have been made, it cannot be ascertained.

SECOND: That your Complainant and Respondent were married in the State of Pennsylvania, on June 2nd, 1939, and lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit, December 17th, 1940.

THIRD: That on to-wit, December 17th, 1940, the Respondent cursed, abused and threatened to kill the Complainant and attempted actual violence to her person; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give your Complainant every reason-

able apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that the Respondent would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, Complainant prays that your Honor will, by proper process, make the said SAMUEL J. COOPER party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same, within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, your Honor will give and grant unto her a decree of absolute divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent, SAMUEL J. COOPER; Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
