This cause coming on to be heard on the original petition for condemnation, service on the parties as required by law, order of the Probate Judge denying the right of condemnation, notice of appeal, appeal bond filed by the petitioner, defendants' motion to dismiss appeal, cross motion by petitioner, and other pleadings and testimony of the witnesses heard ore tenus, and the Court having considered the same, and is of the opinion that petitioner is entitled to proceed with these proceedings;

II

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

- 1. That the defendants' motion to dismiss the appeal be, and the same is, hereby denied.
- 2. That the petitioner's motion to allow the Probate Judge to place his written approval on the appeal bond dated as of June 28, 1963, is hereby allowed.
- 3. The petitioner is entitled to condemn the property of the defendants as described in the original petition for condemnation.
- 4. The determination of the damages to be awarded the defendants shall be set for trial by jury as provided for by law.
