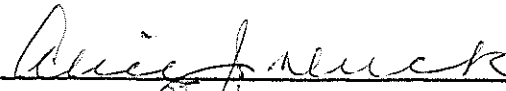

COUNT II:

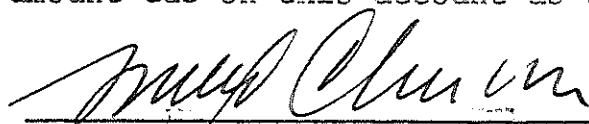
