The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of FOUR HUNDRED TWO & 50/100 (\$402.50) DOLLARS, balance due by promissory note made by him on the 19th day of April, 1956, to the First National Bank of Bay Minette, Alabama, in the original sum of \$532.50, payable in four quarterly installments each in the sum of \$133.00, the first installment due and payable July 30th, 1956, and the balance payable on same day of each successive quarterly thereafter, which said promissory note was on April 12th, 1957, for value received endorsed and transferred by the said First National Bank of Bay Minette, Alabama, to the said Plaintiff, and on May 15th, 1963, the said Defendant did pay to the Plaintiff, on said note the sum of \$20.00, interest payment, which said note with interest thereon is still due and unpaid.

And the Plaintiff alleges that in and by said note the Defendant did waive all right of exemption under the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, as to the collection of the said debt, and the Plaintiff claims the benefit of such waiver.

And the Plaintiff further alleges that in and by said note

the Defendant agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee , and the Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of SEVENTY FIVE & No/100 (\$75.00) DOLLARS, as a reasonable attorney's fee in the premises.
