TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT, SITTING IN EQUITY.

Comes your Complainant, Paralee Grace, and respectfully exhibits this her Bill of Complaint against Jackson Grace, Respondent and shows unto your Honor as follows:

ONE: Your Complainant is a married woman over the age of twenty-one and the Respondent is a married man over the age of twenty-one. The Complainant is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and the Respondent is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. Both the Complainant and the Respondent have been bona fide residents of the State of Alabama for one year next preceding the filing of this Bill.

TWO: The Complainant and Respondent intermarried on or about the 13th day of October, 1913 in Monroe County, Alabama and now are and ever since have been husband and wife.

THREE: Your Complainant shows unto your Honor that there are seven children, three over the age of twenty-one and four minor, namely:

Jimmy Grace born in 1915 now twenty-five years old; Mary Grace born in 1916 now twenty-four years old; Willie Grace born in 1918 now twenty-two years old; Ligon Grace born in 1920 now twenty¹⁸ years old; Jackson Grace born in 1924 now seventeen years old; Ruby Grace born in 1931 now ten years old and Mauline Grace born in 1933 now eight years old born to Complainant and Respondent.

FOUR: That on diverse occasions Respondent has conducted himself towards Complainant in such a manner as to cause her to be apprehensive of violence attended with danger to her life, limb and health; that some time during April in 1941 the Respondent told the Complainant that he was through with her and called her "An old _____". Complainant avers that Respondent was in a great rage when he talked in this manner and Complainant was afraid the Respondent would strike her so that she was in fear of her life.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Complainant also prays your Honor to grant to her all appropriate and legal process and that the same be directed to the said Jackson Grace, Respondent, commanding him to personally appear before the Honorable Court within the time required by law, and to then and there answer fully and completely the several paragraphs of this Bill of Complaint, and that he be required to abide and obey all orders and decrees of this court, which to your Honor may seem meet and proper.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Complainant further prays that she be granted a divorce between herself and Respondent and that the bonds of matrimony between them be separated. That she be awarded the care and custody of the children.

Complainant further prays that an order be rendered directing the Register to hold a reference to determine the amount which Respondent should pay to Complainant for maintenance and support and care of the children pending this litigation and for the services of her solicitors and that it also be determined at such reference or references the amount which should be paid to her permanently; for the right to remarry at the end of sixty days from the date of the signing of the final decree.

Complainant further prays for such relief that she may be entitled to receive in equity and good conscience.
