SETTLEMENT, PETITION, PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE, AND JUDGE'S ORDER OF APPROVAL, UNDER WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW OF ALABAMA

Against : CARNEY TIMBER LANDS Employer. The undersigned being the only parties interested in the above entitled matter, hereby petition the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement, and agree and represent to the Court as follows: That they are subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Alabama, as amended. That the said employee, aged 23, residing at Star Route A, Atmore, Alabama Alabama, who can Kot read and understand the English language, did on the 17th day of DECEMBER 19 62 on or about o'clock M, sustain injury by accident while employed by said employer, which injury occurred at Baldwin County, Alabama, resulting in ____disability of said employee and consisted of <u>5% Permanent Partial</u> (Specify disability extent and type) Employee standing between drawbar and rear of tractor. Operator put machine in motion, employee fell over drawbar. Whiplash lesion of the neck, resulting in 5% Permanent Partial Disability to the body as a whole. That said employee was receiving, at the time of injury, wages at the rate of \$ 40.00 per week. Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the employee is entitled to and shall receive compensation for said injury from the employer beginning February 22nd 1962, at the rate of \$22.00 per week during disability—4 Weeks Temporary Total Disability; payable as follows: 4 Weeks TT Disability @ \$22.00 per week, or \$88.00; then 296 weeks Permanent Partial @ \$1.10 per week or \$325.60: Making a lump sum settlement of \$291.81 .; all subject to the limitations of said Act, and the employee agrees to give proper receipts for each payment made hereunder. The employee acknowledges that he has received to date medical and surgical treatment and benefits given by said Act and the employer agrees to continue to furnish the same, if any be necessary, to the extent and in the manner required by said Act. The employee agrees to present himself for examination, or if physically unable to do so, to submit to examination by the physician or physicians designated by the employer, when requested. This settlement is substantially in accordance with Sections 278 and 279 of the 1940 Code of Ala., as amended. When all payments hereunder have been made the employer shall be, and hereby is released from all claims on account of said injury, under said Act or otherwise.
