COUNT ONE

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant Seven Hundred Seventy-eight and 71/100 Dollars (\$778.71) due by account on, to-wit, the 26th day of August, 1963, with the interest thereon, which is past due and unpaid. Plaintiff avers that the said account represents building materials furnished by the Plaintiff to the Defendant, which was furnished for and which was used in the construction or improvement of certain real estate of the Defendant in Baldwin County, Alabama, described as Lot # 17 of East Robertsdale Heights Subdivision of a part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 6 South, Range Four (4) East, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama in Book 19, pages 59-62. The Plaintiff claims a lien on said real estate as provided by law for mechanics and materialmen, and plaintiff further avers that on, to-wit, the 24th day of

October, 1963 it filed in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in which county said property is situated, a statement in writing, certified by its President who has knowledge of the facts therein stated, containing a just and true account of the debts secured by said lien after all just credits had been given, a description of the property on which the lien is claimed, and the name of the owner thereof, which said instrument is of record in the office of said Judge of Probate, in Lien Book 006, pages 199-200. Wherefore Plaintiff prays that said lien may be established upon said property, and that the same may be condemned to be sold for the purpose of satisfying said demand and lien together with the interest thereon.

Plaintiff further shows that under the terms and conditions under which the sale and purchase of the material was made, the Defendant agreed to pay interest at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum after maturity and all attorney's fee for collection, and all personal exemptions were waived, of which the Plaintiff now claims the benefit, and claims the further and additional sum of \$116.80 as attorney's fee.

Plaintiff files herewith an itemized statement of account, verified by affidavit of E. R. Patterson, President of Gatlin Lumber Company, Inc., a corporation, which said itemized statement is specifically made a part hereof.




