

#### COMPLAINT

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) damages for that heretofore on to-wit September 8, 1962, at a point on Baldwin County Road No. 11, which is a public road in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a point approximately .3 mile South of U. S. Highway No. 98, the defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle as to cause it to run into, upon or against an automobile in which the plaintiff was riding and as a proximate result of the negligence of such defendant the plaintiff was injured as follows: her pelvic bone was broken; she suffered a fractured skull; several of her ribs were broken and cracked; she was caused to have double vision; she was cut, bruised and made sick,

sore and nervous; she spent much time in a hospital and under a doctor's care in and about the treatment of her said injuries; she has been made extremely nervous and upset; she suffered severe pain and mental anguish and was caused to incur large medical and hospital bills and she is permanently injured. Plaintiff avers that all of her injuries and damages were the proximate result of the negligence of the said defendant at said time and place, hence this suit.
