The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), that for heretofore, on, to-wit, May 12, 1962, the Plaintiff was driving a combine over and upon U. S. Highway 98, a public highway in the State of Alabama, approximately two miles West of Foley, Alabama, and at such time and place, an automobile, to-wit, a 1958 Cadillac, being driven by the Defendant ran upon and against the combine of the Plaintiff, causing great damage thereto, in that the left rear side and end of the combine was bent, smashed and otherwise damaged and injured, and that Plaintiff was required to expend sums for the hire of a combine to harvest his crops through loss of use of his combine, all caused by the negligence of the Defendant, in that he negligently caused, allowed or permitted the said automobile operated by him to run upon, into or against the combine of the Plaintiff, and as a proximate result and consequence thereof, the Plaintiff's combine was damaged and injured as aforesaid, and he was deprived of the use thereof, all to his injury as hereinabove set out.

TESTIMONY ON WRIT OF INQUIRY.

HERSHIE E. GUTHRIE, THE PLAINTIFF, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN,

TESTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

Examination by Cecil G. Chason.

Q. You are Mr. Hershie E. Guthrie?

A. Yes sir.

Q. On or about the 12th day of May, 1962 , were you driving on your Combine on U. S. Highway 98, a public highway in the State of Alabama?

A. Yes sir.

Q. At that time, I believe you were west of Foley, in Baldwin County, Alabama?

A. Yes sir.

Q. At that time, Mr. Guthrie, was your combine struck or hit by an automobile driven by a James Warren Smith?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Do you recall, Mr. Guthrie, the cause of the collision?
- - - How it happened?

A. Yes sir; I was going to turn on this highway into Bon Secour - I don't know the number of the road, and there was one truck and two cars behind me and I put out my hand and they all slowed down waiting on me to make the turn and this fellow came up and passed the three vehicles and caught

me just as I had practically completed the turn and hit the back end.

Q. You were turning at the intersection of the Bon Secour Road?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Was there damage done to your combine?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Were you at that time of the year using your combine?

A. Yes sir; I was bringing it from Foley where I had had some work done on it.

Q. Were you required to hire a combine to do the work you could have done with this equipment?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Mr. Guthrie, did you pay for the cost of repairs to your combine?

A. Yes sir.

Q. With the cost of the repairs and the hiring of combines to do your work while this combine was out of condition, how much damage did you suffer?

A. About \$1,000.00
