Alabama, commanding him to bring the body of Rusty Lavene Steele, before
your Honor at the time and place to be by you appointed.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Deceit Pro Confess~~ on answer and waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Delene Steele is forever divorced from the said Louis T. Steele for and on account of

~~Cruelty-- It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Complainant have and she is hereby awarded the permanent care, custody and control of Rusty Steele, a boy, born to the union of said parties; with visitation rights being hereby given the respondent. Further ordered that the Respondent pay the sum of \$25.00 each month as support for the said minor child, Rusty Steele; It is further ordered that the Respondent pay the sum of \$25.00 per month as support for Shewanda Rena Ganey, complainant's child by a previous marriage, until such time as respondent no longer draws a Government allotment for said child.~~

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Louis T. Steele the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.
