

TO THE HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURN, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Comes your petitioner, C. G. CHASON, as Attorney of Record for the Plaintiff, who is over the age of twenty-one years and respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:
