JUDGMENT BY DEFAULT

On this day the Plaintiff moved for a Judgment by Default and it appearing to the Court that personal service was had on the Defendant on the 13th day of February, 1964, and he, being duly called, failed to appear, said judgment was granted on an itemized and verified statement of account, and damages were assessed at FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY TWO AND 36/100 (\$532.36) DOLLARS, AND,

As to Count I, proof was had touching the lien claimed and the amount of the indebtedness, whereupon the court does find that the Plaintiff is entitled to the sum of THREE HUNDRED FORTY NINE AND 12/100 (\$349.12) DOLLARS, the amount claimed, plus interest in the sum of \$13.96, making a total sum of THREE HUNDRED SIXTY THREE AND 08/100 (\$363.08) DOLLARS, together with the costs of this cause, and that a lien upon said property described in the complaint, viz:
