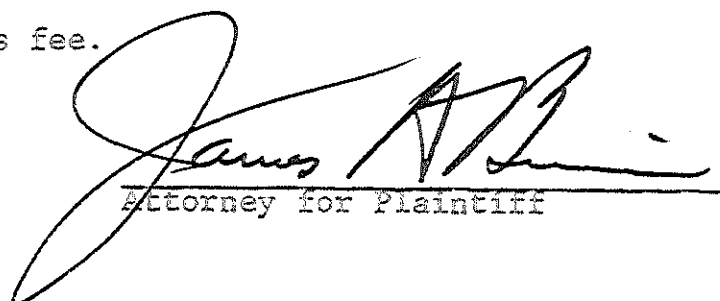

COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Eighty-four Dollars, (\$184.00), due by promissory note made by the Defendant on the 3rd day of December 1960, and payable on the 3rd day of August 1963, with interest from the 3rd day of August 1963, at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum.

Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note, the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing, or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.

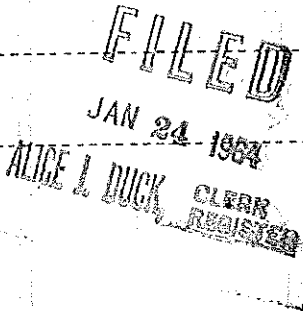
