

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Four Hundred Eighteen and 93/100 Dollars, due by promissory note made by the defendant on the 21st day of July 1961, and payable on the 10th day of January 1962, with interest from the 15th day of January 1964, at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum.

Plaintiff avers that in and by the terms of said note the defendant waived all right to exemption under the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, and of this waiver plaintiff now claims benefit.

Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note, the defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing, or attempting to collect or secure said nte, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the plaintiff further claims of the defendant the further and additional sum of Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.
