

COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$1400.00) as damages for that, on, to-wit: The 31st day of August, 1963, at the intersection of Summit Street and White Avenue in the city of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, the Defendant did so negligently operate a 1956 GMC pickup truck as to cause or allow the same to run into or against a motor vehicle owned by the Plaintiff, and as a proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant, aforesaid, the automobile belonging to the Plaintiff was damaged in this: ^{to-wit:} The front bumper, the right front fender, the right front door, the right rear door were bent, damaged or broken, the front windshield and the window on the right side of the automobile were damaged or broken; the front seat was bent, damaged or broken; the steering wheel was bent, damaged or broken; the radiator was bent, damaged

or broken; it was necessary to paint the automobile where repaired and the Plaintiff was deprived of the use of said automobile for five weeks, all to the damage of the Plaintiff in the sum above mentioned, hence this suit.
