The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Six Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$665.00) due by Promissory Note made by him on November 27, 1962, and payable in six (6) installments of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each and one (1) installment for the balance due, the first installment being due and payable on November 30, 1962, and the remaining installments on the corresponding day of each successive week thereafter for seven (7) installments, together with interest from maturity on each installment at 8% per annum.

The Plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting the same including a reasonable attorney's fee, whether by suit or otherwise, and the Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) as such reasonable at-

torney's fee.

The Plaintiff further alleges that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant waived as to this debt or any extension or renewal thereof all rights of exemption under the Constitution and under all laws thereof and of this waiver the Plaintiff now claims the benefit.
