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
MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Now comes the plaintiff in the above styled cause and moves that a summary judgment be rendered against Ray D. Bridges, as Sheriff of Mobile County, Alabama, and against St. Paul Mercury Indemnity Company, Inc., a Corporation, as the surety on his official bond, as said sheriff, for the sum of Nine Hundred Sixty-three and 21/100 Dollars (\$963.21) and the costs of court for and on account of the following:

That heretofore on to-wit, September 3, 1962, a judgment was rendered out of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in the case of Elsie G. Myers, complainant, vs. Alvin J. Myers, respondent, which was case number 5959 in Equity, in which decree the plaintiff was awarded the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) to be paid by the respondent, Alvin J. Myers; that on to-wit, January 15, 1963, an execution was issued out of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, against the said Alvin J. Myers in the amount of Eight Hundred Ten and 85/100 Dollars (\$810.85) and which execution was received by the said Ray D. Bridges, as Sheriff of Mobile County, on or about January 18, 1963, and returned by him to the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, on September 12, 1963, marked "No Property Found". Plaintiff avers that at all times from January 18, 1963, until September 12, 1963, the said respondent, Alvin J. Myers, had real property in Mobile County, Alabama, in considerable excess of the sum of Eight Hundred Ten and 85/100 Dollars (\$810.85) of which fact the said defendant, Ray D. Bridges, as Sheriff of Mobile County, Alabama, had due notice. Plaintiff further

avers that the said defendant, Ray D. Bridges, as Sheriff of Mobile County, Alabama, could have, by due diligence, made the said money on the said execution;

Wherefore, the plaintiff moves for a summary judgment for the amount of the said execution, interest, and ten percent damages thereon in accordance with Section 595 of Title 7 of the 1940 Code of Alabama, together with the costs of this proceeding, which motion is made against Ray D. Bridges, as Sheriff of Mobile County, Alabama, and St. Paul Mercury Indemnity Company, Inc., a Corporation, as surety on his official bond as such Sheriff.
