WHEREAS, John Earle Chason has made affidavit as required by law that Floyd T. Grice believes the process of garnishment is necessary to obtain satisfaction of said judgment, and that John Dillon d/b/a Foley Dairy has, or is believed to have in his possession or under his control money or effects belonging to the Defendant, or that he has or is believed to be indebted to the Defendant, or to be liable to the Defendant on a contract for the delivery of personal property or on a contract for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property.




