My name is Mary Grdjan. I am the complainant in this cause for divorce against Blas Grdjan, the respondent. I am a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama and am over the age of twenty-one years. I have been a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, for more than one year next preceding the filing of my bill of complaint in this cause, and in fact have resided here continuously for more than three years. The respondent is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, but is temporarily in Baldwin County, Alabama, and is over the age of twenty-one years.

I and the respondent were lawfully married in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on November 6, 1920, by a minister of the gospel, and lived together as man and wife until August 15, 1939. On the date of August 15, 1939, the respondent voluntarily abandoned me and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since said last date. My husband wanted me to come from Milwaukee, Wis., down here to our place at Dyas, Alabama, and he was to stay on for a short time and then come on down here himself. He refused to come on down and stay here and stopped sending me any money or helping me in any way, so that I together with my son were and have been forced to make a living as best we could by farming and whatever work he could get. I therefore charge and state that my husband voluntarily abandoned my bed and board more than two years next preceding the filing of my bill of complaint.
